

Summer Work for incoming Spanish 1 students for the 2018-2019 school year at Riverdale High School with Michael Bourbina Jr.

Inside the following pages are lists of vocabulary that you will be using throughout the upcoming school year.

The summer work has two steps:

Step 1: Either highlight in yellow (if you have a yellow highlighter) or underline all of the words that you see that are cognates. Cognates are words that are the same in two different languages. In this case, I'm asking you to highlight or underline all of the words that you already recognize in Spanish because they are either exactly the same in English, or close enough to the same, that you would not need to look the word up. You can include more words, if you already know more words than just the cognates.

Step 2: Put a star next to the 10 most difficult words or expressions on each of the ten pages. When finished, you should have 100 of the most difficult expressions that you anticipate having to learn this year. Try to start looking at those 100 most difficult words or expressions so that they will not be so difficult for you during the school year.

When you have completed these two steps, you have completed your summer homework for Spanish. **This homework is due the first day of school.**
